What have we been learning?

This half term, we have been learning all about conflict and how it affected people. The children learnt lots about the First World War and how and why it began. In English we have been reading Letters from the Lighthouse and the children have produced historical narratives set in World War II. Both Year 6 classes enjoyed a trip to the zoo where we learnt all about evolution and how different animals adapt to survive.

What are we learning next?

Maths

We will be learning about angles, shape coordinates and ratio in maths this half term.

Science

We will be continuing to learn about evolution and how animals adapt over time to survive their changing habitats.

English

We will be learning all about migration and the Windrush generation by reading Windrush Child. We will be writing balanced arguments and journalistic writing.

History

We will continue our topic about conflict and resolution by learning all about the Second World War, which will include learning about Dunkirk, The Blitz and life in Nazi Germany. We will also learn about the occupation of Jersey and how the people of Jersey were affected by the war.

Homework

A big well done to those children who are completing their homework at home and practicing their reading and times tables knowledge. This extra work really shows. Unfortunately, there are still children not completing their homework. Parents, please work with your child to ensure that homework and home learning is completed.
